↳ makes readers feel pity for the men.

Evidences → moments in the story, poem

Quotes → used to back up the evidences.

Man on the boat are spiritually and physically like the cigars.

They are so resilient ~~and~~ but are fighting against something so powerful like nature and fate.

↳ cigars symbolise duality between hope and hopelessness.

Gulls → shows that you don't understand the situation until you experience

Captain keeping people calm, makes readers admire his authoritarianism and guidance. Even in time of struggle, he is able to lead his crew.

↪ he is determined, resilient, courageous.

Correspondent → empathic, understand the situation now, understand the pain of soldier now.

He understands that he is as much part of the indifference as the ppl on the shore.

Can explore his indifference parallelism of his indifference to indifference of man to other people suffering.

Despite being of different classes and groups they can work together
